Most of his large commissioned sculptures have been done in pinus radiata, one of the biggest being the five pine sculptures owned by the South Waikato District Council which took Rolly six months to complete in 1989. He is also well known for designing excellent hollowing tools that is a result of over 15 years of experimentation and testing.
